## REQUEST FOR REACTIVATION STATUS

Enclose \$50.00 fee

**Request for reactivation of PI license can only occur during the current licensing period.**

After expiration of initial license, you must complete the renewal process (PI-21, PI-27, PI-6, fees, photos, and current bond or insurance information). An investigator may reactivate their status in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 259-061-0170.
