

¹ Although there are two Assistant Attorney Generals who work in Linn County, one of these AAGs also carries cases in neighboring Lincoln County.

² This number is based on the total number of children in care and in involuntary in home services. That number is divided by 1.9 (the average number of children per family) to get an estimate of total DOJ cases.

³ In this mode there are some situations where a case counts for more than one case under the 80 caseload limit because of the amount of work associated with the case. Examples of weighted cases include cases where an attorney represents multiple siblings in the same case or a complex termination of parental rights case.
