2010 RENEWALS are almost finished. Thank you to all who helped make the renewal process go more smoothly. You should have received your license, valid through December 31, 2011, in the mail. If you have not renewed by now, you have missed the deadline to renew without a late fee. It will now cost you an additional \$150 to reinstate your license to practice. How can you renew online? Use this link or cut and paste:

You must enter your last name, your four-digit license number and the last four digits of your Social Security Number.

~ Contact this office if you want the renewal sent via email to you; you can print this out and mail it to our office with your check or money order. Remember you must include the \$150 restoration fee as well as the renewal fee.

LICENSE FEES: Fees have not been raised since 2003, yet the cost of administration continues to increase. *The OBNM will be increasing renewal fees with the 2011 renewal. The expected increase will be about \$50 per licensee. You will be kept informed as the Legislative session progresses and our budget goes before a committee for consideration.*
