### 1) Licensure

19 new applications have been received and 13 licenses have been issued in 2016. There are currently 170 active applications- including 66 practicing residents. There are 1,876 licensees: 1,500 active, 192 semi-active, 182 inactive, and 2 suspended.

### 2) Consumer Protection

15 complaints have been filed in 2016. There are currently 42 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 31 licensees, 4 applicants, and 7 unlicensed practice cases. There are 4 contested cases in process, and 3 cases on appeal.
