

***Call for Applications for the
Metrics and Scoring Committee and Hospital Metrics Advisory Committee
Oregon Health Authority***

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is currently accepting nominees to participate in two of its metrics committees. Brief descriptions of the goals and work of these committees can be found below.

Nominations

OHA is seeking at least three new Hospital Metrics Advisory Committee members for a two-year period beginning in late April 2015, specifically two CCO representatives and one measurement expert. Committee members serve initial two-year terms and may be re-appointed at the discretion of the Director of the Oregon Health Authority for additional one-year terms.

OHA is seeking at least three new Metrics and Scoring Committee members for a two-year term beginning August 2015, specifically one CCO representative, one measure expert, and one member at-large. Committee members serve initial two-year terms and may be re-appointed at the discretion of the Director of the Oregon Health Authority for additional one-year terms, for a total of four years on the Committee.

Individuals can apply to serve on both Committees.

Hospital Metrics Advisory Committee

The Hospital Metrics Advisory Committee was established in 2013 by HB 2216 for the purposes of recommending performance measures and targets for hospitals to advance health system transformation, reduce hospital costs, and improve patient safety. Members of the nine-member Committee are appointed by the Director of the Oregon Health Authority.

Members must include:

- (a) Four representatives of hospitals;***
- (b) Three individuals with expertise in health outcomes measures; and***
- (c) Two representatives of coordinated care organizations.***

Metrics and Scoring Committee

The Metrics and Scoring Committee was established in 2012 by SB 1580 for the purposes of recommending outcome and quality measures for Coordinated Care Organizations (CCOs). Members of the nine-member Committee are appointed by the Director of the Oregon Health Authority.

The members of the committee serve two-year terms and must include:

- (a) Three members at large;***
- (b) Three individuals with expertise in health outcomes measures; and***
- (c) Three representatives of coordinated care organizations.***
