

HEALTHY FUTURES INCENTIVE 2014

Following is the staff and medical carriers' proposal:

A \$500 gift card will be awarded to the subscriber or covered spouses/ domestic partner following a random drawing from all covered subscribers and covered spouses/ domestic partners that completed the health assessment available through their medical carrier on or after January 1, 2013, and on or before May 31, 2014, and those individuals who have an approved exception to the requirement. (We have a policy, process and form for exceptions that has been authorized by DOJ and communicated to entities and is posted on our website.)

- ✓ There will be a total of 23 gift cards available:
- ✓ The drawing will take place on Tuesday, July 1, 2014, and the winner notifications will take place within 7 to 10 days of the drawing, requesting the winner return an acknowledgement that he or she has won the award and will accept it knowing that for active employees of an entity participating in OEBC it will be processed as taxable income and reported on their 2014 W-2;
- ✓ The winner can decline the award and if he or she does, it will be returned to a pool and will be awarded to the entity with the highest participation percentage;
- ✓ Moda Health and Kaiser Permanente will communicate that the award was made and provide a copy of the acknowledgement to the employing entity, if applicable.
- ✓ Employing entity will take the necessary steps to have the awarded amount included in the employee's taxable income, withholding appropriate taxes and reporting the money as earnings on the 2014 W-2; and
- ✓ OEBC will provide a process that will allow the entity to request OEBC pick-up the "tax" tab for the "entity's" match on taxes (not the employee's taxes, just the employer taxes).
