

## Revisions to 2013-14 Summary of Medical and Pharmacy Benefits since original posting to website May 6, 2013

May 16, 2013 Revision

- Alternative Care Benefit - Removed the statement “Moda Health/ODS alternative care copayments do not apply to Out-of-Pocket Maximums.” since all the Moda Plans now have coinsurance for alternative care rather than copayments.
- Removed \* from all instances of “\$0” since waiving the deductible is not needed when there’s no payment needed.
- Changed all instances of “No charge” to “\$0” for consistency
- Kaiser Plan 1, Durable Medical Equipment benefit – Added parenthetical “(applies to Maximum Out-of-Pocket)” to draw attention to this change from previous plan years
- Emergency Room Benefit:
  - Changed Description from  
“Emergency Room Copay (waived if admitted unless noted otherwise)”  
to  
“Emergency Room (copay \$ amounts listed are waived if admitted)”
  - Kaiser Plan 2 - changed from “20% (not waived if admitted)” to “20%”
- Combined “Imaging (CT, PET & MRI)” and “Sleep Studies” into one row because benefits are the same. Moved “Lumbar Discography” into this same row (removing it from the “Upper Endoscopies” row) to correct the Kaiser Permanente plan benefits for this service.
- Created a new row for “Viscosupplementation” (removing it from the “Upper Endoscopies” row) to correct the Kaiser Permanente plan benefits for this service.
- Upper Endoscopies Benefit:
  - Kaiser Plan 2 - Removed the asterisk indicating deductible waived. On this plan, this benefit is subject to deductible.
- Outpatient Rehabilitation (physical, occupational & speech therapy) Benefit:
  - Kaiser Plan 2 – moved asterisk indicating deductible waived from “\$35 per visit\* ...” to “\$35\* per visit ...” for consistency of placement with other benefits.
- Changed footnote language for double-asterisk (\*\*) from  
“Additional Cost Tier copayments, \$100 Imaging/Sleep Studies/Upper Endoscopies/Viscosupplementation/Lumbar Discographies copayments, and \$500 Bariatric Surgery copayments do not count toward Deductible or Out-of-Pocket Maximum on any plan except Plan H.”  
to  
“Additional Cost Tier copayments (\$100 or \$500 as applicable) on Plans A – G do not count toward Deductible or Out-of-Pocket Maximum. The \$500 Bariatric Surgery copayment does not apply toward Deductible or Out-of-Pocket Maximum on any plan except Plan H.” for clarification on Kaiser plans.

August 14, 2013 Revision

- Moda Health/ODS Plans A – G, Mental Health Outpatient Services, PPO Network benefit changed (from 20% coinsurance after deductible) to match System of Care (Moda Medical Home) benefit (copay, deductible waived). This change was made to ensure compliance with mental health parity regulations.
