Acupuncture	Used for acupuncture therapy by inserting one or more fine needles into the individual as dictated by acupuncture meridians for the treatment of substance abuse. Electrical stimulation may or may not be employed with this procedure.	Medical licensure consistent with practice	Per initial 15 minutes	\$14.23
Acupuncture	For each additional 15 minutes of personal one-on-one contact with the individual, with re-insertion of the needle, with or without electrical stimulation (1 unit = 15 minutes, list separately in addition to primary). Alcohol and/or Drug Assessment	A comprehensive assessment that includes all pertinent bio-psychosocial information, as identified by the individual, family and collateral sources, for determining a diagnosis and to plan individual services and supports. One assessment equals one unit of service, one unit per billing regardless of length of time or if it takes multiple sessions to complete the initial assessment. Care Coordination/Case Management	<p>Care coordination includes facilitating communication between the family, natural supports, community resources, and involved providers and agencies; organizing, facilitating and participating in team meetings; and providing for continuity of care by creating linkages to and managing transitions between levels of care and transitions (OAR 309-019). Care coordination requires gathering data and interviewing individuals to ensure that they meet positive outcomes as well as meet the GPRA requirements for the Access to Recovery initiative.</p> <p>Case management of individuals needing services related to substance use disorders, provides assistance and care coordination based on the needs of the individuals. The care coordinator assesses the needs of the individual, assists in the development of recovery plans to benefit the individual, as well as the implementation of the plans. Review and evaluates the individual's progress in relation to the plan.</p>	<p>At a minimum possess a high school diploma (degree preferred). Ability to engage and facilitate recovery services through oral and written communication. Outpatient Treatment Group Counseling	Reference Addictions and Mental Health (AMH) OAR 309-019 Provides the individual support in a group setting assisting the individual with managing, reducing or resolving substance use.
