Project Deliverables:

- Implement the “Be the ONE” outreach project in Clackamas County middle and high schools
 - ▶ Utilize a variety of outreach platforms, including social media, print materials, presentations, the Be the ONE documentary and I am the ONE diary series
 - ▶ Provide monthly communication through email distribution regarding upcoming trainings and student projects
- Deliver the Mental Health First Aid youth training to targeted middle and high school staff and student peer leaders
 - ▶ Provide training to all 27 pilot schools selected within Clackamas County
 - ▶ Deliver a total of 30 trainings to approximately 25 staff per training
- Provide mentorship, consultation and collaboration opportunities to Mental Health First Aid trainers
 - ▶ Monthly trainer check-in sessions to support successful trainings and project implementation
- Provide Be the ONE project oversight
 - ▶ Monthly project partner check-in meetings
 - ▶ Quarterly review process for evaluation reports
