### **Project Deliverables:**

- Provide suicide prevention training for up to 40 behavioral health therapists in Central Oregon
- Provide a community event with a keynote presentation by an expert in the field of suicide prevention for up to 200 community members
- Provide 5 community events (Prineville, Redmond, Bend, Sisters & LaPine) using a recognized expert in the field of bullying prevention, focusing on understanding our kids' social world
- Provide school staff in-service training on bullying prevention focused on putting into practice safer social and learning environments
- Provide eight Question, Persuade and Refer (QPR) presentations to Central Oregon communities reaching a minimum of 100 community members
- Provide a minimum of 2 Asist trainings for 48-60 community agency and school staff members
- Provide a minimum of 2 school districts the opportunity to implement an evidence-based suicide and/or bullying prevention curriculum
- Assess a minimum of 50 primary care settings (or 200 primary care clinicians) on their current screening and referral practices for depression and suicide risk
