#### **Project Deliverables:**

- Provide integrated preventive services to homeless and at-risk children, youth and their families in order to promote stability, foster resiliency and provide connections to a web of community-based supports
  - ▶ Provide outreach and basic needs/emergency services to 1000-1200 youth and/or families through
    - Countywide street outreach to homeless youth and families
    - School-based and community outreach to partnering agencies and providers
    - Centrally located community hubs (food pantries, health centers, churches, etc.)
  - ▶ Provide coordinated prevention services for up to 300 individuals, including:
    - Risk assessment
    - Goal plans
    - Monitoring school attendance and academic progress
    - Linking to additional support services/referrals
    - Fostering social and emotional competence and coping skills
    - Helping youth remain in school or origin
    - Preventing families from being displaced
    - Preventing youth from entering the street
  - ▶ Providing enrichment opportunities and skill development
    - Onsite: harm reduction and life skills classes, DHS services, art program, tutoring, etc.
    - Offsite: school sports/activities, afterschool/summer programs, YMCA, etc.
  - ▶ Provide referral services to Jackson County Mental Health and/or additional drug& alcohol counseling services
