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MHS 30 Security Part C

Security services identified in the PSRB Conditional Release order which are not medically approved services but are required for purposes of individual and public safety at a rate based on a determination of intensity and risk as identified in the Security Services Matrix.

- i. On the risk continuum; individuals are evaluated as being at Low, Medium or High Risk of committing violent acts if placed in the community through either a Violence Risk Assessment or the START, which reviews the specific risk estimates at regular intervals.
- ii. On the care needs continuum a combination of diagnostic review and LOCUS score would identify a level of high, medium, or low care needs with the intersection between risk and care needs creating a Security Rate.

This process identifies a monthly Security Rate which programs can invoice through MHS 30 Part C for individuals on Conditional Release.

High Care Needs	\$225	\$450	\$675
Medium Care Needs	\$450	\$675	\$900
Low Care Needs	\$675	\$900	\$1125
