Subject: ICD-10 Communication

To keep you informed, AMH is sending this early communication about the change to ICD-10 Diagnostic Codes. AMH is following the federal and state lead on making the change from ICD-9 to ICD-10 effective October 1, 2015. We are currently in the planning stage and looking at what changes may need to be made to MOTS to add the ICD-10 codes. As we move forward, communication will be sent out to keep you informed on where we are in the process and how system changes are being managed to impact you as little as possible.

AMH recommends that you have all of your MOTS submissions current prior to October 1, 2015. This will help meet compliance with the 90 day status update and 30 day non-Medicaid data submission guidelines, as well as the 7 day new admission, mental health crisis and involuntary service submissions. It will also insure that your files are clean and ready for the new codes. Beginning October 1, 2015, ICD-10 codes will be used for new admissions, status updates, and mental health crisis submissions. Non-Medicaid services provided on or after October 1, 2015 will require ICD-10 codes.
