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


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## COMPASS NEWS!

## **PROJECT UPDATES**

The COMPASS Project team has been busy developing the new data collection system and readying AMH staff and providers to transition to this new system. Over the past month, we have developed and updated many documents that may assist you in preparing for the transition.



### **MOTS Reference Manual:**

This manual is now available on the COMPASS web page at: <http://www.oregon.gov/oha/amh/pages/compass/electronic-data-capture.aspx>.

This document instructs providers on how data elements should be collected. At this point in time, providers should review the document to determine what new data elements will be collected and if and how they may



need to update business processes.

### **Fully Implemented Policy:**

The COMPASS team has developed a Fully Implemented policy document on how each data submission method (Client Entry, OWITS, and EDI) will transition from CPMS to MOTS. It is located at: <http://www.oregon.gov/oha/amh/compass/docs/policy-fully-implemented.pdf>.

### **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):**

The COMPASS FAQ documents have been updated and developed for all MOTS users and for users of specific data submission methods from the questions we have been receiving from providers. ### **Non-Medicaid Services Policy:**

As requested by many providers, the Non-Medicaid Services Policy has been updated to improve clarity of which services should be reported and when to report. The policy is located on the COMPASS web page at: <http://www.oregon.gov/oha/amh/compass/docs/encounter-data.pdf>.

### **DSM-V and ICD-10 FAQ:**

Due to the questions received by providers regarding these topics, the COMPASS project team has draft a Frequently Asked Question (FAQ) document and it is located on the COMPASS web page at: <http://www.oregon.gov/oha/amh/compass/ICD-10-FAQ.pdf>.



**OR Medicaid Provider Number:** A policy was recently developed regarding the use of this number for the registration/set up process within MOTS. AMH will use the OR Medicaid Provider number to uniquely identify each behavioral health entity and track performance. Providers will no longer have multiple provider numbers for various programs, as is the current structure within CPMS. Please review this document regarding limitation of using one number for all entities and the process to request a number or additional numbers.
