
## **MOTS CE IS LIVE!**

We currently have a handful of Agency/Facilities that are using the web based tool successfully. Many are still going through the registration process and will be submitting data through MOTS Client Entry soon.

They help us set up new users and passwords and have been very helpful and patient, explaining to our providers, how to go about getting access to the new MOTS CE data entry tool.
