

Wraparound & Systems of Care

Lower Cost for CCO's

Lessons learned and systemic successes demonstrated by Oregon's Statewide Children's Wraparound Initiative serve as a useful and relevant guide for CCOs. SCWI had 3 demonstration sites serving 240 youth and findings suggest that within a year of implementation, costs for children's mental health services were significantly lower relative to non SCWI sites.

Impacts for one site; cost changes from 2009 to 2012

Overall Cost Increases Slowed

SCWI sites spent less overall than non-SCWI sites during each year studied (graph) and their increase in costs was much smaller. For example, PRTS (psychiatric day treatment services) expenses dropped by about \$4,500 per 1,000 children enrolled from 2009–2011.
