Measure changes in specifications from 2015 to 2016:

OHA is using HEDIS® 2016 specifications for all 2016 measurements. The changes in this measure between HEDIS® 2015 and 2016 include:

- CPT code 58551 is deleted from the Absence of Cervix Value Set.
- LOINC codes 75406-9 and 75694-0 are added to the HPV Tests Value Set (although OHA does not use LOINC codes for measurement calculation).
- HEDIS® 2016 added ‘numerator events by supplemental data’ to the Data Elements for Reporting table. However, OHA does not calculate this measure with any data other than administrative claims.
- HEDIS® 2016 included ICD-10 diagnosis and procedure codes in the Absence of Cervix Value Set.

HEDIS specifications are written for multiple lines of business and include a broad set of codes that could be used for measurement. OHA is not using all codes listed in the HEDIS specifications. Codes OHA is not using include, but are not limited to, LOINC, CPT, and HCPCS codes that are not open to Medicaid in Oregon. A general rule of thumb is that only CPT/HCPCS codes associated with the prioritized list will be used to calculate the measures; however as some measure specifications include denied claims, a claim that was denied because it included codes not on the prioritized list might still be counted toward the measure.

Women 24-64 years of age as of December 31 of the measurement year. See HEDIS® 2016 Technical Specification for Health Plans (Volume 2) for details.

Required exclusions for denominator:

OHA adopts the HEDIS® 2016 optional exclusion rule: Exclude women with hysterectomy with no residual cervix, cervical agenesis or acquired absence of cervix (Absence of Cervix Value Set) any time during the member’s history through December 31 of the measurement year:

Data elements required numerator:

Step1: Women age 24-64 years of age as of December 31 of the measurement year who received cervical cytology (Cervical Cytology Value Set) during the measurement year or the two years prior to the measurement year:

Step2: From the women who did not meet step 1 criteria, identify women 30-64 years of age as of December 31 of the measurement year who had cervical cytology (Cervical Cytology Value Set) and a human papillomavirus (HPV) test (HPV Tests Value Set) with service dates four or less day apart during the measurement year or the four years prior to the measurement year and who were 30-64 years of age on the date of both tests.



For example, if the service date for cervical cytology was December 1 of the measurement year, then the HPV test must include a service date on or between December 1 and December 5 of the measurement year.

Step3: Sum the events from steps 1 and 2 to obtain the rate.
