Data Source: Patient Centered Primary Care Home (PCPCH) enrollment by tier via self-report from CCOs; total CCO enrollment via MMIS/DSSURS

Measurement Period: This measure is looking for total PCPCH enrollment by the end of calendar year 2016 (December 2016). OHA will collect updated PCPCH enrollment rates from CCOs quarterly throughout 2016, but the final calculation will be based on PCPCH enrollment as of December 31, 2016. Due dates for CCOs to report quarterly total enrollment are:

- Q1 2016 – Due May 1, 2016
- Q2 2016 – Due August 1, 2016
- Q3 2016 – Due November 1, 2016
- Q4 2016 – Due February 1, 2017

Benchmark: The PCPCH Enrollment measure does not have a benchmark. Ideally, 100 percent of CCO members would be enrolled in a Tier 3 PCPCH, as per Metrics & Scoring Committee consensus, but CCOs receive credit for this measure on a sliding scale, based on the overall percentage of their membership enrolled in a PCPCH.

Incentive Measure Changes in specifications from 2015 to 2016:

There are no changes in specifications for 2016, however:

- OHA intends to request a member-level attribution file, showing which members are assigned to which certified PCPCHs, at some point during the 2016 measurement year. This file will support more detailed analysis and cross-tabulation with other measures as well as measure validation.
- OHA also intends to begin collecting information on how many CCO members are assigned to NCQA-certified PCPCHs in 2016 as part of the online survey. This information will help inform modifications to the measure for 2017 or beyond, and provide valuable information for the

PCPCH program.

- Measure specifications may need to be modified later in 2016 to accommodate any recommendations from the pending PCPCH Standards Advisory Committee regarding tiers.

OHA will provide additional details via the Metrics Technical Advisory Workgroup.

Measure Details

Data elements required denominator: Total CCO enrollment for the same month of the PCPCH enrollment snapshot (see numerator) multiplied by 3. OHA produces total CCO enrollment from MMIS/DSSURS as of the 15th of the month.

For example, the December 2016 snapshot of PCPCH enrollment will use December 15th, 2016 total CCO enrollment (times 3) for the denominator.

Required exclusions for denominator: None.

Deviations from cited specifications for denominator: N/A

Data elements required numerator: Number of CCO members enrolled in PCPCHs by tier, using the agreed-upon formula: Tier 1 enrollees are multiplied by one; tier 2 enrollees are multiplied by two; tier 3 enrollees are multiplied by three; and the results are summed.

$$(\text{Tier 1 enrollees} * 1) + (\text{Tier 2 enrollees} * 2) + (\text{Tier 3 enrollees} * 3) = \text{numerator}$$

CCOs are contractually obligated to report on the number of members assigned to providers in PCPCH practices on a quarterly basis. CCOs can also provide additional information on the number of health care teams or clinics meeting PCPCH standards, and the number of primary care practitioners accepting members in a PCPCH by tier.

CCOs report on the number of members assigned to providers in PCPCH practices quarterly, via online survey: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/PCPCHReport>. Due dates for each quarter are:

- Q1 2016 – Due May 1, 2016
- Q2 2016 – Due August 1, 2016
- Q3 2016 – Due November 1, 2016
- Q4 2016 – Due February 1, 2017
