# 2013 Final Progress Reports to CCOs

OHA is releasing final 2013 progress reports on April 30<sup>th</sup>.

- The reports will include final 2013 performance data on the 17 CCO incentive metrics, as well as member-level files for validation.
- CCOs will have through May 31, 2014 to review their report and member-level files, and address any concerns with OHA.
- 2013 Quality Pool payments will be made to CCOs in June.

# Year One Technology Plans

- All CCOs submitted their Year One Technology Plans on time.
- OHA has completed the initial review (completeness), secondary (detailed) review, and notified CCOs.
- All CCO Technology Plans were approved between March 11 - April 14, 2014.
- Approval of Technology Plans results in early payment of 75 percent of 3/17<sup>th</sup> of quality pool.

# SBIRT – 2014 Codes

- Two additional codes were identified in 2013 to be added to the SBIRT measure specifications for 2014.
  - G0042 – annual alcohol misuse screening
  - G0043 – brief face-to-face behavioral counseling for alcohol misuse.

# 2015 CCO Incentive Measures

- Committee has already selected one measure for 2015 (sealants on permanent molars for children).
- All current measures and new proposed measures will be included for discussion.
- OHA worked with Michael Bailit to propose process for the Committee's review and selection of measures for 2015.

# 2015 Workplan (High Level)

Step	Description	Timeline
1	Compile all measures for consideration.	By June 13 <sup>th</sup>
1a-e	Obtain feedback from stakeholders and CCOs	By June 13 <sup>th</sup>
2	Review all compiled measures – including current .	Beginning June 20 <sup>th</sup>
3	Select CCO Incentive Measure set for 2015	By August 31 <sup>st</sup>
4	Select benchmarks and improvement targets for 2015 measures	By Oct 31 <sup>st</sup>
5	Publish measure specification sheets / documentation online	By Dec 31 <sup>st</sup>

# Step 1 – Compile All Measures

- Identify all potential measures under consideration as a CCO Incentive Measure for 2015.
- Collect feedback from Committee members, CCOs, OHA offices, CMS, and other workgroups on the existing 17 CCO incentive measures.
- Collect recommendations and suggested new measures from Committee members, CCOs, OHA offices, CMS, and other workgroups.

## Step 1a – 1e

OHA staff will collect feedback on the existing measures and suggestions for potential new measures from:

- Committee – via survey, individual meetings.
- CCOs – via survey, Innovator Agents, and metrics TAG.
- OHA – via survey, staff meetings, document review.

OHA staff will collect this information and distribute it to the Committee in advance of the June 20<sup>th</sup> meeting.

# Step 1f – Presentations

The Committee will hear presentations on potential and future metrics from workgroups, including:

- Long Term Supports and Services – today
- Public Health – today
- Early Learning – today
- Dental Quality Metrics – May 16<sup>th</sup>
- HB 2118 (CoverOregon) metrics – May 16<sup>th</sup>

Are there other areas of interest or workgroups the Committee would like to hear a presentation from to inform the 2015 measure selection?

## Step 2 – Review Measures

The Committee will review all feedback and suggested measures collected through step 1 above, beginning at the June 20<sup>th</sup> meeting.

## Step 3 – Select measures for 2015

The Committee will review 2013 data for each of the existing CCO incentive measures as well as information on each of the suggested new measures to determine the 2015 measure set.

To review measures, the Committee will utilize:

- The measure selection criteria worksheet;
- Seven focus areas included in the Waiver;
- Current CCO and state performance;
- Changes to national measures / guidelines
- Collected feedback.

Measures will be selected by August 31<sup>st</sup>.

## Step 4 – Select benchmarks & improvement targets for 2015

The Committee will determine a benchmark and an improvement target for each of the selected measures.

To select benchmarks, the Committee will utilize:

- All existing benchmarks and improvement targets;
- Current CCO and state performance;
- Changes to national benchmarks / data;
- Collected feedback.

Benchmarks will be selected by Oct 31<sup>st</sup>.

## **Step 5 – Communication**

Communicate final 2015 measure set and benchmarks to CCOs.

## **Step 6 – Publish 2015 Documentation**

OHA will update all materials online by December 31, 2014 to reflect Committee decisions for 2015.
