

“On Deck” / Pending Measures

Pending measures = measures of interest that have not been selected as CCO incentive measures for the current year.

Pending measures are the first measures the Committee will look at when selecting measures for the next year.

Pending measures are considered important, but have not yet been selected as an incentive measure for any of the following reasons:

- Lack of clinical or other data source necessary to calculate;
- Lack of sufficient baseline data;
- Lack of clear or widely accepted specifications;
- Overly burdensome to collect; and
- Not currently appropriate for Medicaid
