

EDI Bulletin – July 30, 2015

ICD-10 testing begins August 3, 2015

As you know, the ICD-10 implementation date of October 1, 2015 is coming soon. All registered electronic data interchange (EDI) submitters must successfully complete ICD-10 testing with DMAP in order to be able to bill for dates of service on or after October 1, 2015.

Beginning on August 3, 2015, EDI Support Services will open testing for fee-for-service 837 Professional and 837 Institutional transactions. (You are not required to test the 837 Dental transactions for ICD-10.)

How to get ready for ICD-10 testing

We will send testing instructions to the EDI Submitter contacts listed in Part 6 of the most current Exhibit B (DMAP 2082) or Exhibit C (DMAP 2083) we have on file.

- **If your primary authorized signer has changed** since we last approved your Trading Partner Agreement (TPA), please complete a new [EDI Registration Packet](#) (DMAP 2080, DMAP 2081 and DMAP 2082 forms).
- **If your signer has not changed, but your EDI submitter (e.g., clearinghouse) has**, send us a new Exhibit A ([DMAP 2081](#)) and Exhibit B ([DMAP 2082](#)).
- **If your signer and EDI submitter have not changed, but the technical contacts for your EDI submitter have** (as listed in Part 6 of the DMAP 2082 or DMAP 2083), send us a new Exhibit C ([DMAP 2083](#)). Include the direct telephone and email addresses of the people you would like us to contact (no group emails or general phone numbers).

You cannot proceed with ICD-10 testing until we can confirm we have your current authorized signer and submitter information on file. You are responsible for maintaining copies of your current registration forms and submitting updates within 5-10 days of the change.
