Subject: Fee-for-service professional claim reprocessing scheduled for December 27, 2014

The weekend of December 27, 2014, the Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) will reprocess claims paid between **January 1, 2013** through **March 31, 2013**, to apply the following rate updates effective January 1, 2013:

- [Relative Value Unit \(RVU\)-based rate updates;](#)
- Federal primary care rates;
- Vaccines for Children administration rate updates, and
- Rates for selected other new procedure codes added after January 1, 2013.

Because of the large number of claims being reprocessed, delivery of the paper remittance advice (RA) may be delayed.

What you will see on the paper RA

The Claim Adjustments section will list the affected claims by original Internal Claim Number (ICN). Each ICN will have an adjustment ICN (beginning with "52") to indicate reprocessing by DMAP.

The "Detail EOBs" will list Explanation of Benefits (EOB) code 4300: View 'Fee-For-Service Professional Claim Reprocessing Scheduled for December 27, 2014' at:

What you will see on the electronic remittance advice or Provider Web Portal

Both the ERA and Provider Web Portal will list the reason for the reprocessing using Adjustment Reason Code 129: 'Prior processing information appears incorrect. At least one Remark Code must be provided (may be comprised of either the NCPDP Reject Reason Code, or Remittance Advice Remark Code that is not an ALERT).'
