Subject: OHA will soon accept competitive applications for Outpatient Day Treatment with Housing Support Services funding opportunities

The Oregon Health Authority's Health Systems Division (Division) is pleased to announce an opportunity to work collaboratively with stakeholders, treatment providers, community partners and CCOs to improve Oregon's continuum of care for individuals seeking treatment for substance use disorder.

\$1.75 million is available to fund the start-up program development of outpatient day treatment (ASAM Level II.5) programs with housing support services, to serve indigent and Medicaid populations.

- CCOs or the Division will reimburse for services to the Medicaid population;
- The Division will reimburse for services to the indigent population through current SE66 contracts.

We will open the Request for Proposal later this year. To apply for this funding opportunity, applicants must provide letters of endorsement from the local CCO and CMHPs. Local treatment programs and community partners may contact you in the near future to ask you for such endorsement.

What should you do?

We would greatly appreciate your consideration and endorsement of qualified applicants. The Division will only consider applications with local CCO and CMHP endorsement for this funding opportunity.

We are pleased to offer this opportunity, and look forward to working with you on this endeavor.
