Dental Sealant Measure Specifications

Measure specifications for the dental sealant incentive metric are available for 2015 and 2016. They are posted online at www.oregon.gov/oha/analytics/Pages/CCO-Baseline-Data.aspx (scroll down to “CCO Incentive Measure Specification Sheets”).

These specifications are final, although they may be updated with any corrections. Please note that the 2015 measure specification sheet will be reposted this month to add the anchor date (which was left off the specification sheet in error).

Dental Sealant Guidance Document

The dental sealant guidance document was revised and reposted in November to reflect the 2016 measure specifications and 2015 legislation regarding the school-based sealant program. Thanks to all of our content experts who helped draft and review the updated guidance document!

Publication of Dental Sealant Measure

OHA will be publishing the CY 2014 baseline and mid-year data (July 2014 – June 2015) for the dental sealant measure in its upcoming January 2016 Health System Transformation Report. The dental sealant measure will be published at the state and CCO level, and by race/ethnicity (at the state level).

OHA is also exploring reporting many of the measures stratified (at the state level) by people with and without disability, and people with and without severe and persistent mental illness (SPMI). This information may also be included in the January report for the dental sealant measure.

OHA will also be publishing the Assessments for Children in DHS Custody measure in the January report, revised to include dental assessments for CY 2014 and the mid-year data point.

Please note OHA cannot report measured at the DCO level, as member assignment is now made at the CCO level, and DCO assignment is managed within the CCO.
