The DHS Web site has moved

The Department of Human Services (DHS) has moved its Web site. The Office of Medical Assistance Programs (OMAP) has a new Internet home page: <http://www.oregon.gov/DHS/healthplan/index.shtml>

From there, you can click your way to all the same OMAP information you were used to. It's just in a new format.

If you go to some of the main DHS Web pages at the old addresses, you will find a forwarding message.

However, DHS could not put redirect notices on all 30,000 of its Web pages. That means if you have marked "favorites" or "book marked" pages on your computer, you will need to locate the new addresses.

A few pages stayed behind

For now, OMAP's administrative rules and staff transmittals are still at their old locations, along with a few other DHS pages. (The new site should link you back there if you start from the new site.)
