OMAP permanently amended administrative rules and updated Rulebooks on the website for the following programs:

General Rules Program:

Effective June 23, 2006: OMAP permanently amended temporary rule 410-120-1295 to reference reimbursement documents with corrected tables.

Pharmacy Program:

Effective June 29, 2006: OMAP permanently amended temporary rule 410-121-0149 to authorize the State to pay for medications for dual eligible clients with Medicare Part D coverage.

No changes were made to the text of the rules above; the permanent dates were placed at the bottom of the rules.
