Highlights of the administrative rule revisions

The following are selected "highlights" of administrative rule revisions effective Jan. 1, 2011. This does not represent all rule revisions, and is not intended to replace policy. General Rules

- 410-120-0030 - CWX (CAWEM Plus) benefits are now available in Lane County.
- 410-120-1230 - Services paid for by managed care plans are no longer exempt from copayment. Some plans are choosing not to collect copayments. If you contract with a managed care plan, check with the plan for their requirements. See the [provider announcement](#) about this change.

Hospice Rules

- New Rule 410-142-0110 – Children who receive hospice care can now also receive covered curative treatment for their terminal condition.

Home Health

- 410-127-0065 - Signature stamps are no longer allowed for home health orders.
- 410-127-0060 - Revised the rate methodology.

Pharmaceutical Services Program

- 410-121-0030 - Semi-annual PDL update. This update includes 42 new drug classes. See [the PDL list](#).
- 410-121-0040 - Revised PA criteria for asthma controllers (LABA/ICS Inhalers) and low-dose Quetiapine and moved the list of drugs requiring PA from administrative rule to the Division's online PA Approval Criteria Guide at www.dhs.state.or.us/policy/healthplan/guides/pharmacy/main.html.
