

Covered/Non-Covered Visual Services Effective January 1, 2010

Beginning January 1, 2010, DHS will reduce visual benefits for non-pregnant adults (age 21 and older) covered by OHP Plus (BMD, BMH or BMM). Children (age 20 and younger) and pregnant women are not affected by the visual benefit reductions.

Non-pregnant, adult OHP Plus clients are no longer covered for refraction and accommodation or hardware services related to glasses or contacts. However, refraction and accommodation and hardware services related to aphakia and keratoconus are still covered for all clients.

For non-pregnant adults covered by OHP Plus:

When billing refraction and accommodation or hardware services for fee-for-service clients diagnosed with aphakia or keratoconus, one of the diagnoses codes listed below must be in the primary position when submitting the claim.

Description
Keratoconus, unspecified
Keratoconus, stable condition
Keratoconus, acute hydrops
Aphakia
Congenital Aphakia (congenital absence of lens)
Absences of eye len(s), such as following Cataract extraction

All claims billed with 367.XXX will be denied.
