

TCM Program Description and Contacts

Targeted Case Management (TCM) Services are case management services furnished to a specific target group of eligible clients under the Medicaid State plan to gain access to needed medical, social, educational, and other services (such as housing or transportation). Case management are services furnished by a case manager to assist eligible clients in gaining access and effectively using needed medical, social, educational, and other services. TCM services are allowable only for clients who are categorically eligible.

The TCM State Plan Amendments are in Supplement 1 of Attachment 3.1A of the Oregon Medicaid State Plan located at www.oregon.gov/OHA/healthplan/pages/stateplan.aspx. They reflect the programs as approved by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). DMAP covers TCM services delivered through the following programs:
