- **To filter by ICD-9 or ICD-10 code**, enter the full code (including decimal point) in the “Search this dataset” box.
- **To filter by description**, enter any full word from the code description in the “Search this dataset” box.
- **To search by partial ICD-9 or ICD-10 code** (*e.g.*, A02 instead of A02.21), click on “More Views,” then click on “Search by ICD-10 code” or “Search by ICD-9 code.” In the resulting “Code starts with” box, enter the first digits of the code.

To save a copy of your filtered dataset, click the **Export** button, then select the format you want to save as. The file will open in a new window for you to save.

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
