<b>Client Pay Form and Policy</b>	<p><b>Dee led discussion</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• OAR 410-120-1280(3)(g) applies and is mandatory for pharmacy providers when member pays for a non-covered medication. Has existed many years.</li> <li>• The group requested changes to standard form 3165 to make more useful for pharmacy settings. For example, add assurance that provider will rebill if it turns out service covered, possibly allow application to future drug refills.</li> <li>• Discussed length of time pharmacy should keep forms.</li> </ul>
