Landlord Trainer Application For
Manufactured Dwelling Park Landlord Continuing Education

To be eligible for consideration the applicant must:

Be a legal entity and authorized to submit an Application;

Be an Oregon based statewide nonprofit trade association registered to do business in Oregon representing manufactured housing interests;

Possess nonprofit status: Provide association's current articles of incorporation as a Non-profit trade association;

Represent Manufactured Housing interests: Provide evidence the statewide non-profit has demonstrated viability of no less than two years

Have a Statewide presence: Provide evidence of significant statewide presence via membership by and/or programs provided to landlords of manufactured home parks.

Have Expertise: Illustrate/document knowledge of Residential Landlord and Tenant statutes, ORS Chapter 90, ORS 105.105 to 105.168, ORS 446, ORS 456.579, fair housing law and other laws relating to landlords and tenants of manufactured home park communities.

Have Instructional skill: Provide evidence of experience providing training

Be in Compliance: If the trade association, or a trainer of the association, owns/manages or is responsible for the compliance of a manufactured dwelling park the owner/landlord of the park must be in compliance with the registration and training requirements under Oregon law, ORS 90.732 and 90.734.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Along with the documentation required to prove eligibility, an Applicant must submit the following:

1. The completed trainer application;
2. The association's training curriculum;
3. A list of the association's trainer/facilitators;
4. *A list of any manufactured home parks the association or its trainers/facilitators own/manage or have the responsibility to ensure compliance under ORS 90.732 and 90.734;*
5. The association's schedule of training dates for the calendar year;
6. A description of the association's training evaluation plan;
7. The association's plan for publicizing its services to the Manufactured Home Park landlord population at large; and
8. The association's plan for providing a record of certificates of completion to Oregon Housing and Community Services.
