# CURRENTLY AVAILABLE OHCS DATA

- Poverty Rate, by County
  - Overall, Nonwhite, Hispanic
- Severe Housing Problems, by County
  - # and % of Extremely Low Income (ELI) households with one or more severe housing problems
    - Substandard units, severe overcrowding, severe housing burden
  - Available by Race/Ethnicity
- Ratio of affordable and available units per 100 ELI households, by County
- Homeless Students, by County (from Department of Education)

# CURRENTLY AVAILABLE DHS DATA

- Number and Percent of people receiving TANF, by County
  - Available by Race/Ethnicity
- Victim Rate per 1,000 Children, by County
  - Victims of Abuse and Neglect
  - Available by Race/Ethnicity, and Age
- Foster Care Children, by County
  - Available by Race/Ethnicity and Age

# POVERTY RATES

Oregon's Poverty Rate = 16%

- Multnomah County

- Share of state's population in poverty = 21%
- Poverty Rate = 18%

- Marion County

- Share of state's population in poverty = 9%
- Poverty Rate = 19%

- Klamath County

- Share of state's population in poverty = 2%
- Poverty Rate = 19%

# NONWHITE POVERTY RATES

Oregon's Nonwhite Poverty Rate = 25%

## ■ Multnomah County

- Share of state's nonwhite population in poverty = 32%
- Nonwhite Poverty Rate = 28%

## ■ Marion County

- Share of state's nonwhite population in poverty = 12%
- Nonwhite Poverty Rate = 29%

## ■ Klamath County

- Share of state's nonwhite population in poverty = 1.6%
- Nonwhite Poverty Rate = 27%

# SEVERE HOUSING PROBLEMS

Percent of Oregon's ELI Households with Severe Housing Problems = 73%

## ■ Multnomah County

- Share of state's ELI population with severe housing problems = 28%
- % of ELI households with severe housing burden = 72%

## ■ Marion County

- Share of state's ELI population with severe housing problems = 7%
- % of ELI households with severe housing burden = 74%

## ■ Klamath County

- Share of state's ELI population with severe housing problems = 2%
- % of ELI households with severe housing burden = 75%

# SHORTAGE OF AFFORDABLE AND AVAILABLE UNITS

Number of affordable and available units per 100 ELI renter households in Oregon = 21

## ■ Multnomah County

- Share of state's shortage of A&A units = 29%
- Ratio of A&A units to ELI households = 22

## ■ Marion County

- Share of state's shortage of A&A units = 7%
- Ratio of A&A units to ELI households = 16

## ■ Klamath County

- Share of state's shortage of A&A units = 1.5%
- Ratio of A&A units to ELI households = 21

# HOMELESS STUDENTS

Percent of enrolled students in Oregon who are homeless = 3.7%

## ■ Multnomah County

- Share of state's homeless students = 19%
- Homeless students as a % of all students in the county = 4.4%

## ■ Marion County

- Share of state's homeless students = 7.6%
- Homeless students as a % of all students in the county = 2.6%

## ■ Klamath County

- Share of state's homeless students = 1.9%
- Homeless students as a % of all students in the county = 4.1%

# TANF RECIPIENTS

## ■ Multnomah County

- Share of state's TANF recipients = 24%
- TANF recipients as a % of all people in the county = 2.7%

## ■ Marion County

- Share of state's TANF recipients = 12%
- TANF recipients as a % of all people in the county = 3.7%

## ■ Klamath County

- Share of state's TANF recipients = 1.8%
- TANF recipients as a % of all people in the county = 2.2%
