RE: Commission Action on Rules, December 2015 Commission Meeting

On December 18, 2015, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission took the following rulemaking action(s):

INITIAL & TEMPORARY ACTION

- **Direct Shipper Package**
 - The amendments in the bill added to and revised the qualifications and requirements for the direct shipment of malt beverages, wine, and cider directly to a resident of Oregon.

Action: The Commission initiated rulemaking and approved the temporary rules to become effective January 1, 2016.

TEMPORARY ACTION

- **845-025-1115 - Denial of Application**
 - The temporary rule passed by the Commission in November of 2015 misinterprets a statutory definition by errantly using “tax lot” which has a different definition than an “entire lot or parcel”. The rule change is needed to correct the conflicting rule language.

Action: The Commission amended the temporary rules to become effective January 1, 2016.

FINAL ACTION

- **Distillery Package**
 - HB 2567 passed in the 2015 Oregon legislative session with an effective date of June 25, 2015. It makes several changes to ORS 471.230 (the

distillery license statute). The following amendments are required to align the rules with the statute changes.

Action: The Commission approved the amendments for final action to become effective February 1st, 2016.
