***Attorney General's Model Rules for Rulemaking of Procedure***

*The Commission adopts, by reference, the Attorney General's Model Rules of Procedure, effective January 15, 2004. The Commission's supplemental rules for contested cases are in division 3 of this chapter.*

**(1) The Attorney General's "Model Rules for Rulemaking," effective May 1, 2014, are hereby adopted by reference as permanent rules for rulemaking procedure. The Attorney General's "Model Rules for Rulemaking" are set forth in OAR 137-001-0005 to 137-001-0100.**

**(2) The Commission's administrative rules for contested case proceedings, miscellaneous proceedings, and orders in other than contested cases are set forth in Division 003 of this chapter.**
