**Oregon Beverage Recycling Cooperative (OBRC)**

has applied for

**expansion of the Beverage Container Redemption Center  
at 12403 NE Glisan St, Portland**

The applicant proposes to expand the radius of the convenience zone from 1.5 to 2.0 miles and add a second convenience zone including the following stores:

If the application for expansion is approved by OLCC, the redemption center will provide redemption services for bottles, cans and other containers that are subject to an Oregon bottle deposit. Redemption services include accepting returnable cans and bottles and other containers and paying the bottle return fee. This center will accept containers that are subject to the Oregon 5-cent deposit, even if the containers were purchased at other Oregon stores. **If approved, the stores listed in Zone 1 will no longer accept returnable containers and the stores listed in Zone 2 may limit returnable containers to 24 containers per day.**

The OLCC will approve a redemption center if it will provide a convenient service to consumers for the return of empty beverage containers. The applicant proposes to be open seven days per week from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm in the summer, and from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm during the rest of the year. The center proposes to accept up to 350 containers per person per day and to make special arrangements to accept larger quantities from fundraiser and donation accounts.

If approved, the redemption center expansion is anticipated to be completed in February 2016. As part of our application process, we are posting this public notice.
