## **Free ID checking classes available at the OLCC**

**BEND, Ore.** – The Bend Regional Oregon Liquor Control office will offer free training for servers, bartenders, managers, and clerks who sell alcohol. The training will be held at the Bend Regional office from 6-7 p.m. on the first Wednesday of each month beginning Feb. 4, 2009.

The training will focus on ID checking and on how to recognize visibly intoxicated persons, and it will also include a question and answer session at the end.

“We provide this class free-of-charge to give our licensees, service permit holders, and sales clerks another tool they can use to prevent selling alcohol to minors or intoxicated people,” said Jason Evers, Bend Regional Manager.

Licensees who wish to make this refresher training available to their staff, licensees whose clerks are required to take an ID checking class after a violation, as well as licensees who are current participants in the Responsible Vendor Program may enroll their employees, as the class will count towards all of the aforementioned requirements.
