OLCC Commissioners ratify nine sanctions

PORTLAND, Ore. – At their monthly meeting May 13, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following sanctions based on stipulated settlements:

The Old Silver Dollar, 38726 North Main Street, Scio; has paid a \$1,815 civil penalty *and* will serve a 25-day suspension for two violations. The first violation was for denying a Linn County Sheriff's deputy entrance to the premises during regular business hours. The second violation was for permitting Member Royd Kloucek to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit. Licensee is The Old Silver Dollar, LLC, Sharon Kloucek and Royd Kloucek, members.

Patricia Gibbons, Service Permittee, Scio; will serve a 23-day suspension for denying a Linn County Sheriff's deputy entrance to the licensed premises during regular business hours.

For an employee(s) failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him/her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he/she reasonably appeared to be under 26:

Keizer Mart, 4940 River Road N, Keizer; will pay a fine of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day suspension. Licensees are Eunhee Kim and Sejun Kim.

Your Break Tavern, 210 E. Main St., Silverton; has paid a civil penalty of \$1,485. Licensees are Eric L. Braff and Tracy A. Braff.

Space Age Fuel, 16875 SW Pacific Highway, King City; will pay a \$3,795 civil penalty or serve a 23-day suspension. Licensee is Space Age Fuels, Inc.; Jim Pliska, Linda Pliska, and Harold Pliska, corporate principals.

C & M Tavern, 841 SE Cass Street, Roseburg; has paid a civil penalty of \$3,795. Licensee is Click, Inc.; Clarence Berg, corporate principal.

For permitting an employee(s) to sell, mix, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

Stanford's Restaurant & Bar, 14801 Kruse Oaks Drive, Lake Oswego; will pay a civil penalty of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Restaurants Unlimited, Inc.; Steven Stoddard, Robin Galloway, Attila Szabo, Thomas Taylor, Case Kuehn and RU Corp., corporate principals.

Scoreboard Tavern, 2290 Front Street, Salem; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Grossman Investments, Inc.; Lyle Grossman and Lisa Kinnee, corporate principals.

Kelli's Café, 14717 SE Division, Portland; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Henry & Ok Corp, Henry Kang and Ok Hee Kang, corporate principals.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
