Check local liquor store for Fourth of July hours

PORTLAND, Ore. – The Oregon Liquor Control Commission reminds customers that liquor stores in Oregon have the option to open on Fourth of July.

State law provides that liquor agents have the discretion to be open or closed on Sundays and holidays. Fourth of July is one of the nine state holidays defined by state law.

“This allows liquor agents to have the flexibility of staying open or celebrating the holiday with their friends and family,” said Brian Flemming, Retail Services Director. Retail liquor agents in Oregon are independent small business owners who are privately contracted to sell distilled spirits.
