OLCC Commissioners approve new liquor licenses and issue sanctions for liquor law violations

Portland, OR – On Thursday, April 24 as the first day of a two-day monthly commission meeting, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission approved the following new liquor licenses through stipulated settlement:

Saithong Thai, 710 SW 2nd. Ave., Portland; was approved for a liquor license with restrictions. Licensee is Saithong Thai, LLC; Saithong Khunburan Webster, Byron Webster, Jo Ann Afelbil, members.

Eazy A Market, 395 West 11th Ave., Eugene; was approved for a liquor license with a restriction. Licensees are Rubyn Maroke and Sukhpaul Maroke.

Gtano's, 218 SW G Street, Grants Pass; was approved for a liquor license with a restriction. Licensees are Juan Carlos Gonzalez and Iracema Liliana Vargas.

Sube, 40 SW 3rd Ave., Portland; was approved for a liquor license with restrictions. Licensee is Sube, LLC; Azim Patel, member.

The Commissioners approved the following liquor license actions:

Casey's, 412 SW 4th Ave., Portland was approved as a new outlet. Licensee is Imagine Portland, Inc.; Karl Wilgus, corporate principal.

Toor Food Market, 486 East Main Street, Estacada was approved for a change of ownership. Licensee is Toor Food Market, Inc.; Sukhjit S. Toor, corporate principal.

The Commissioners ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Astoria Coffee House, 243 11th Street, Astoria; will pay a fine of \$2,970 or serve an 18-day liquor license suspension for two violations. The first violation was for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he reasonably appeared under 26 years old. The second violation was for permitting an employee to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit. Licensee is ACH, Inc.; Anthony Danton, corporate principal.

Blue Ocean Thai Cuisine, 1040 Commercial Street, Astoria; will pay a fine of \$2,970 or serve an 18-day liquor license suspension for two violations. The first violation was for permitting an employee to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit. The second violation is for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he reasonably appeared under 26 years old. Licensee is Lucky 777, LLC; Jason Manotham and Bungorn Manotham, members.

District (formerly known as Harlem), 220 SW Ankeny, Portland; will pay a fine of \$660 or serve a four-day liquor license suspension for permitting customers to take open containers of alcoholic beverages from the licensed premises. Licensee will also receive a letter of reprimand. Licensees are The Ankeny Group, LLC; Douglas Posey III, Andrew Murdoch, and Chet Fiedler, members; and Koi Fusion, Inc.; Bo Kwon, corporate principal.

Tavin's Pub, 102 NE Russell Street, Portland; will serve a 30-day liquor license suspension for failing to maintain liquor liability insurance or a bond with corporate surety in the amount of \$300,000 or more. Licensee is Tavin's Pub, LLC; Marilyn Parrish and Angela Robertson, members.

Dirty Bar and Grill, 35 NW 3rd Avenue, Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day liquor license suspension for permitting disorderly activity when an employee harassed, threatened, and physically harmed a passerby. Licensee is Vegasstars, LLC; Christopher Lenahan, Jessica Yang, Jacob Wang, and Gary Yang, members.

Sushi Boat West Linn, 21900 Willamette Dr., #205, West Linn; will pay a fine of \$2,640 or serve a 16-day liquor license suspension for two violations. The first violation was for failing to verify the age of a minor when she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years old. The second violation was for permitting an employee to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit. Licensee is Y & H, LLC; Minjung Kang, member.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

Voodoo Martini, 507 E. 1st Street, Newberg; will serve a 21-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Voodoo Martini, LLC; Alexander Arthur and Cal Erath, members.

Edgefield Brewery, 2126 SW Halsey Street, Building F, Troutdale; has paid a fine of \$825. Licensee is McMenamin's, Inc.; Michael McMenamin and Brian McMenamin, corporate principals.

B & S Market, 926 SW Highway 99W, Dundee; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Chong Park.

Fulio's Pasteria, 1149 Commercial Street, Astoria; has paid a fine of \$1,155. Licensee is Fulio's, LLC; Peter Roscoe and Patricia Roscoe, corporate principals.

Jade Green Palace, 3018 Pacific Avenue, Forest Grove; will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every customer who appears to be under 26 years old. Licensee is Jade Green Palace, Inc.; Lina Lei and Joe Lei, corporate principals.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

Local Lounge, 3536 NE MLK Jr., Blvd., Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Triple 3 Enterprises, LLC. Harry Jarvis, member.

Alexander's Deli & Pub, 015 NE 181st, Portland; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Wong's LLC; Danny Wang and Miao Wu, members.

Herb's La Casita Restaurant & Lounge, 515 SE Rogue River Highway, Grants Pass; will pay a fine of \$2,145 or serve a 13-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is HMK Corporation; Beverly Parker, corporate principal.

Applebee's Neighborhood Grill & Bar, 2625 Liberty NE, Salem; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee is Apple Oregon, LLC; Apple American Group II, LLC and Lorin Cortina, members.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
