## **OLCC Commissioners issue sanctions for liquor law violations**

**Portland, OR** – At their monthly commission meeting, May 16, 2014; the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

**THE VAULT**, 209 East 2<sup>nd</sup>, The Dalles; will pay a fine of \$4,950 or serve a 30-day liquor license suspension for two violations. The first violation is for a history of serious and persistent problems involving disturbances, unlawful activities or noise, including fights, altercations, harassment, and trespass. The second violation is for permitting unlawful activity when employees provided private security services without being certified to do so. The license will be renewed with restrictions. Licensee is Park Avenue Jones, Inc.; Michael Leash, corporate principal.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

**7-ELEVEN #2362-23726B**, 6630 SW Nyberg Road, Tualatin; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensees will also be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensees are Gary Benke and Lorraine Benke.

**OLD TOWN PIZZA**, 5201 NE MLK Jr. Boulevard, Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Milne, Inc.; Adam Milne, Jason Joss, and Eric Aust, corporate principals.

**SISTERS MAINLINE STATION**, 1001 Railway, Sisters; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will also be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Sisters Mainline Station, LLC; Steven Rodgers and Robin Rogers, members.

**HOOT OWL MARKET**, 6730 SW Capitol Highway, Portland; has paid a fine of \$330. Licensee will install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under 26 years old. Licensee is Ling's Grocery, Inc.; Michael Ling, Li-Ping Ling, Matthew Ling, and Timothy Ling, corporate principals.

**BOB'S HANDY PANTRY**, 3354 SE Milwaukie Avenue, Portland; has paid a fine of \$330. Licensee will install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under 26 years old. Licensee is M Hannah, LLC; Young Kim and Joung Kim, members.

**DRINA DAISY**, 915 Commercial St., Astoria; will pay a fine of \$330. Licensee will install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under 26 years old. Licensee is Quantum Pacific, LLC; Fordinka Kanlic and Kenneth Bendickson, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

**GUADALAJARA GRILL**, 3969 Commercial Street SE, Salem; will pay a fine of \$1,815 or serve an 11-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Guadalajara Grill, Inc.; Vicente Plascencia and Sonja Plascenia, corporate principals.

**PHEASANT CAFÉ & LOUNGE**, 149 E Main Street, Hermiston; will pay a fine of \$2,475 or serve a 15-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Jack Baker Enterprises, Inc.; Cherie McLeod, corporate principal.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
