## **OLCC Commissioners approve sanctions for liquor law violations**

**Portland, OR** – At their monthly meeting Friday, July 25, 2014, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission approved the following sanctions based on stipulated settlement:

**Georgetown Brewing Company**, 5200 Denver Avenue S, Seattle; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension for an employee drinking alcohol while on duty. The licensee is Shortround Corporation.

**Kells Irish Pub**, 112 & 114 SW 2<sup>nd</sup>, Portland; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension for permitting an employee to provide private security services without being certified to do so. Licensee is Kells, Inc.; Denis Gerard McAleese and Lucille McAleese, corporate principal.

**Tequila's Sports Bar and Grill**, 1111 Main Street, Suite A, Klamath Falls; will serve a 30-day liquor license suspension for failing to maintain liquor liability insurance or a bond with a corporate surety in the amount of \$300,000 or more. Licensee is Juan McGee.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

**VFW Post #4248**, 7118 SE Fern, Portland; will install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every customer purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears to be under 26 years old. Licensee is VFW Post #4248 Portland, Charles Rose and Patrick Jordan, members.

**Cornelius Fast Serv**, 990 N Adair, Cornelius; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Cornelius Fast Serv, Inc.; Robert Barman and Mary Barman, corporate principals.

**Stop N Save Market #8**, 1737 Salem Ave SE, Albany; will pay a fine of \$1,815 or serve an 11-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Preet, Inc.; Inderjit Dhaliwal, Varinder Dhaliwal, and Talwinder Dhaliwal, corporate principals.

**Chinese Garden Restaurant & Lounge**, 410 SE 162<sup>nd</sup>, Portland; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee is San Hwa Enterprises, Inc.; Sui Wah Chan, corporate principal.

**Pueblo Viejo**, 2602 S. Santuan Highway, Lebanon; has paid a fine of \$330. Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every customer purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears to be under 26 years old. Licensee is El Paraiso, Inc.; Barnardo Magana and Elia Morelos, corporate principals.

**Courtney 76**, 13939 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Milwaukie; has paid a fine of \$3,795. Licensee is Stein Oil Company, Inc.; Robert Stein, Susan Stein, Anne Gray, and Mary Berryman, corporate principals.

**El Mariachi Loco II**, 114 Laneda Ave., Manzanita; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is El Mariachi Bautista, Inc.; Rosalba Cisneros, corporate principal.

**Ponderosa Pizza Parlor**, 52574 hwy 97, La Pine; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is PCK, Inc.; Phyllis Kremer, corporate principal.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

**Giuseppe's Italian Restaurant**, 17937 SE Stark Street, Portland; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee is Giuseppe's Italian Restaurant, Inc. Joe Panza and Linda Panza, corporate principals.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents.
