OLCC Commissioners appoint Madras liquor store agent, approve liquor licenses and sanctions for liquor law violations

PORTLAND, Ore. – At its monthly meeting on May 28, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission appointed the following liquor agent contract:

Madras, Store #1148; Jered Toomey

Retail liquor agents are private, independent contractors; they are not state employees. The Retail Services Division of the OLCC works closely with liquor agents to help them understand and follow liquor regulations and store operating procedures.

The Commissioners approved the following new liquor license applications with restrictions:

Marmo (F-COM), 1037 SW Morrison, Portland. Licensee is Marmo, LLC; Kevin chambers and PAWS Family Trust, members.

Hi-Fi Music Hall (F-COM), 44 East 7th Ave., Eugene. Licensee is Tree House Six, LLC; Danny Kime and Mike Hergenreter, members.

Club Sinrock (F-COM), 12035 NE Glisan, Portland. Licensee is Club Sinrock, LLC; Timothy Lyons and Rebeckah Lyons, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Trio Club, 909 E. Burnside, Portland; will serve a 23-day liquor license suspension for failing to follow a minor control plan when minors were allowed into an area that is prohibited to minors. Licensee is Trio Club, Inc.; Foo Hong Foong, corporate principal.

Stickmen Brewery & Skewery, 40 N. State Street, Lake Oswego; will pay a fine of \$4,950 or serve a 30-day liquor license suspension for two violations. The first violation is for permitting noisy activities. The second violation is for an employee drinking on duty. Licensee is Stickmen, LLC; Timothy Schoenheit and Jonathan Turner, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

Two Brothers Mexican & Bar B Que Restaurant, 38786 Pioneer Blvd., Sandy; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Angelberto de la Cruz.

KB Teriyaki Grill, 19660 SE McLoughlin, Gladstone; will serve a 21-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Koffee Barn, Inc., John Barkle III and Lynne Barkle, corporate principals.

Life Source Natural Foods, 2649 Commercial Street SE, Salem; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Beamer's Natural Food Stores, Inc., Alexander Beamer, corporate principal.

Ami Japanese Restaurant, 634 SE Cass, Roseburg; will pay a fine of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day liquor license suspension. Licensees are Kwang Park and Young Park.

Tabor Bread, 5051 SE Hawthorne Blvd., Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Tabor Bread, LLC; Tissa Stein, member.

Hubbard Market, 3574 Pacific Hwy 99E, Hubbard; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Robert Kim.

7-Eleven 21486D, 1560 9th Street, Florence; will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day liquor license suspension in addition to installing age verification equipment and using the equipment to verify the age of every customer purchasing alcoholic beverages who reasonably appears to be under 26 years old. Licensee will also be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. The licensee is LKGG Enterprises, Inc.; Balwir Jutla, corporate principal.

76 Food Mart of Canby, 453 SE 1st Street, Canby; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Virk Petroleum West Linn, LLC; Kulwant Kaur, member.

Mohawk Chevron, 111 Mohawk Blvd., Springfield; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Thabet Management, Inc.; Lutfi Thabet, corporate principal.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

Moose Lodge #2191, 48066 Highway 58, Oakridge; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Oakridge Moose Lodge #2191; Dennis Foster, Arthur Wood III, Daniel Pugh, Melvin Bruner, Hillis Knowles, Clay Tillery, members.
