OLCC staff holding additional informational meeting for applicants of Portland Metro Retail Liquor Locations

Portland, Oregon – Due to high interest, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission will hold an additional informational meeting for applicants of the 17 possible new retail liquor location opportunities in the Portland metro area.

The informational meeting will be held Tuesday, December 15th at 6:00 p.m. at the OLCC's Milwaukie Headquarters office at 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd.

At the meeting, OLCC staff will review the application packet, selection criteria, compensation, and open recruitment timeline. OLCC Commissioners are looking for creative, innovative proposals that could include a variety of different models such as adding a spirits section to an existing retail store, a traditional standalone liquor store, or a boutique store.

The open recruitment period will end Friday, January 15, 2016. All applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. PST on the deadline to be considered.
