

Scenic Bikeway Designation Process

Proponent submits application including:
Proposed route
Letters of support from governing bodies of road management agencies and adjacent public landowners

OPRD reviews the application for completeness. The Coordinator sends completed applications to the State Bikeway Committee, or sends written feedback to Proponent explaining why it was not advanced.

State Bikeway Committee reviews completed application, rides the route to rate it using the Bikeway criteria

Route does not score well. Route can be rejected outright or with suggestions to resubmit after issues area addressed.

If route scores well The Bikeway Committee recommends the route to the OPRD Director for approval
The Proponent is asked to start **developing a Scenic Bikeway Plan**.

Proponents and OPRD holds public meetings
Proponent submits draft of Bikeway Plan for feedback from the Coordinator

State Bikeway Committee reviews and possibly sends back suggestions for improvement
State Bikeway Committee approves final draft Scenic Bikeway Plan

State Bikeway Committee consults with Oregon Recreation Trails Advisory Committee

State Parks Director's recommendations and summary of public comment forwarded to the State Parks Commission votes on Designation

Implementation and Review

Proponent starts to implement Bikeway Plan
Proponents complete annual reviews
Bikeway committee holds five-year review
