Topic: Report of Actions Taken under Delegated Authority for Natural Resources Management from August 19, 2014 through October 23, 2014.

Pursuant to a duly adopted delegation order, and acting in accordance therewith, the Director, or her designee, has approved the following actions on behalf of the Oregon Parks & Recreation Commission:

SCENIC WATERWAYS NOTIFICATIONS

August 21, 2014, approved Notification of Intent (2a-199-14) from Charles and Kathleen Popish to construct a garage addition within the Middle Deschutes River Scenic Waterway.

August 25, 2014, approved Notification of Intent (2a-200-14) from Paul Fulton to construct a detached garage within the Middle Deschutes River Scenic Waterway.

September 3, 2014, approved Notification of Intent (2b-209-14) from Michael and Linda Eisele for a 400ft. additional garage and living space to an existing structure within the Upper Deschutes River Scenic Waterway.

October 13, 2014, approved Notification of Intent (2a-201-14) from Ryan Duble for the construction of a single family dwelling within the Middle Deschutes River Scenic Waterway.

October 15, 2014, approved Notification of Intent (2b-210-14) from Greggery and Kelle Jones for an addition to an existing structure within the Upper Deschutes River Scenic Waterway.

OCEAN SHORE ALTERATION DECISIONS

October 10, 2014, an Ocean Shore Alteration Permit was issued to Dale E. Anderson (BA# 695-14). The project involves the reconstruction of an existing riprap revetment along 150 feet of shoreline fronting five contiguous vacant lots. Plans call for armor rock 3.0 to 5.0 feet in diameter, keyed into the beach sand and placed in an interlocking state approximately 18 feet in height above beach level, with a slope of 2H to 1V or a maximum of 1.5H:1V. The proposed riprap revetment will project approximately 30 to 41 feet onto the ocean shore and tie into an existing riprap revetment to the north (BA# 477-99) of the subject property. The properties are located at the south end of North Pacific Street, Rockaway Beach. Tillamook County Assessor's Map #2N-10W-32CB, Tax Lots 7800, 7900, 8000, 8100 and 8200.

Topic: Recreation Trails Program Grant Awards

Background:

The Recreation Trails Advisory Committee met October 22-24, 2014 to evaluate and rank the attached list of grant applications. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department Director has administratively approved funding for the attached list based on available funding and is providing this list for Commission's review.

The Recreation Trails Grant Program (RTP) is federally funded under the Federal Highway Administration. Federal guidelines provide funding for motorized, non-motorized, and diverse use projects related to recreational trails. The Director approved projects have been submitted to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration for their review and authorization.

Grant applications were solicited and OPRD received 59 qualified applications seeking funding assistance for \$4,164,174.84. Of these 49 were non-motorized and 10 motorized projects. The Recreational Trails Advisory Committee heard presentations and based upon the program's evaluation criteria, scored the projects.

For non-motorized projects, available funding for this grant round is \$1,528,097.94. Based on the Advisory Committee ranking, funding was recommended for 26 of the 49 projects. Of the \$697,741.84 designated for motorized use, the Advisory Committee recommended funding for all 7 of the 10 requests.

If additional funds become available, or if any approved projects are withdrawn, additional grant awards could be provided to projects below the available funding line.
