

# Saturday Program Dedicates Capitol

## New Statehouse Will Be Turned Over to State With Ceremonies

Plans are now completed for dedication of Oregon's new \$2,500,000 state capitol building on Saturday, members of the state capitol reconstruction commission announced Wednesday.

The dedication address will be given by Leslie M. Scott, Portland. There will be remarks by C. C. Hockley, regional director, public works administration, and a statement for the capitol reconstruction commission by Robert W. Sawyer, head.

The building will be presented by J. A. McLean, chairman of the capitol reconstruction commission, with Governor Charles H. Martin giving the acceptance address.

Others on the program include the Rt. Rev. Benjamin D. Dagwell, D. D., Episcopal bishop of Oregon and the Rt. Rev. Edward D. Howard, archbishop of Portland in Oregon.

The Oregon national guard band and Willamette university glee club will furnish music.

The dedication ceremonies will begin at 2 p.m., followed by a public reception in the executive department.

The Balcon chamber of commerce also will hold a reception during the afternoon.
