Have you tested your smoke alarm lately? @OSFM recommends monthly testing of all types of smoke alarms. #firesafeOregon

Replace smoke alarms every 10 years or when they fail to respond to operability tests. #firesafeOregon

Teach children what your smoke alarm sounds like and what to do if they hear it- crawl low under smoke and get out. #firesafeOregon

Smoke alarms: install them, test them, and protect your family from fire. #firesafeOregon

Do not take down smoke alarms even temporarily. Remember, a smoke alarm that doesn't work, doesn't work. #firesafeOregon

Install a smoke alarm on every floor of your home, outside sleeping areas (hallway), and in each bedroom. #firesafeOregon

Make sure that everyone in your home can recognize and be awakened by the sound of a smoke alarm. #firesafeOregon

Keep smoke alarms working by following manufacturer's instructions for cleaning. #firesafeOregon

You have about 3 minutes to escape during a fire. A working alarm can give you life-saving time to get out. #firesafeOregon

Renters are required to maintain smoke alarms by testing them regularly and replacing the batteries when they run low. #firesafeOregon
