

2012 Oregon Fire Clock

Oregon's structural fire agencies responded to 11,207 fires in 2012. This represents a 5.9% increase from 2011. Even though this is an increase, Oregon fires have still declined by an average of approximately 3% annually over the last ten years. This trend indicates that the fire prevention education focus and efforts of the Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) and Oregon's fire agencies are making a positive impact across the state.

On average, a fire department in Oregon responds to:

A fire every 47 minutes

A structure fire every 2 hours, 17 minutes

A house fire every 3 hours, 7 minutes

A vehicle fire every 5 hours, 58 minutes

An outside fire every 1 hour, 36 minutes

On average, fires in Oregon resulted in:
estimated property loss of **\$406,781** every day
one civilian death every **17.4 days**
one civilian injury every **29.5 hours**
one firefighter injury every **4.8 days**
