

Klamath County Local Emergency Planning Committee (KCLEPC)

1100-1200 hrs - 7 May 2015

Meeting called to order at 1100 hrs by Klamath County Acting Emergency Manager George Buckingham.

Present: Monte Keady Chief (Administration)-Fire District #1; Rod Denson (City of Klamath Falls); Greg Ayers – Cerule LLC; Robert Roach, Sr. Environmental Analyst | PacifiCorp Hydro Resources (via conference call).

Buckingham gave a brief history of the KCLEPC, his role as Acting Emergency Manager and KCEM volunteer and passed out LEPC Member Manuals to those present.

Buckingham outlined the KCEM concept of dedicating one resource (Buckingham) to writing the LEPC Response Plan utilizing the template provided by the Fire Marshalls Office. The members concurred with this approach. He will commence and keep the committee informed regarding progress. He will be seeking input from members; particularly in regards to contacts and existing response plans.

Keady moved that LEPC officers be elected as all previous office holders have left the LEPC. Motion passed unanimously.

Rod Denson was nominated and elected by acclamation as President.

Monte Keady was nominated and elected by acclamation as Vice-President.

George Buckingham was nominated and elected by acclamation as Secretary.

Buckingham will distribute Member Manuals, the Response Plan Template and the Oregon State Fire Marshall LEPC Emergency Plan Crosswalk to all members (via email).
